I. GRADES AND GRADING SCALE

- A. Grades are based on a point system:
 - 1. Short tests and Quizzes10-30 pointsDaily Papers & Projects10-50 pointsWorksheets20-50 pointsChapter Tests70-150 pointsCornell Notes3 points
- B. Grading Scale: 90% 100% = A
 - 80% 89% = B 70% - 79% = *C*
 - 60% 69% = D
 - 0% 59% = F

II. CHAPTER TESTS

- A. Neatness may affect your score, I will not try to decipher poor writing.
- B. Spelling is important
- C. Make-up tests <u>may be essay</u> in nature. It will <u>not</u> be to your advantage to miss class on the day of an exam. (School functions can be an exception if arranged).
- D. If a student misses the day before a previously announced test, he/she will be expected to take the test on the announced day!
- E. No talking during the testing period.
